Online giving

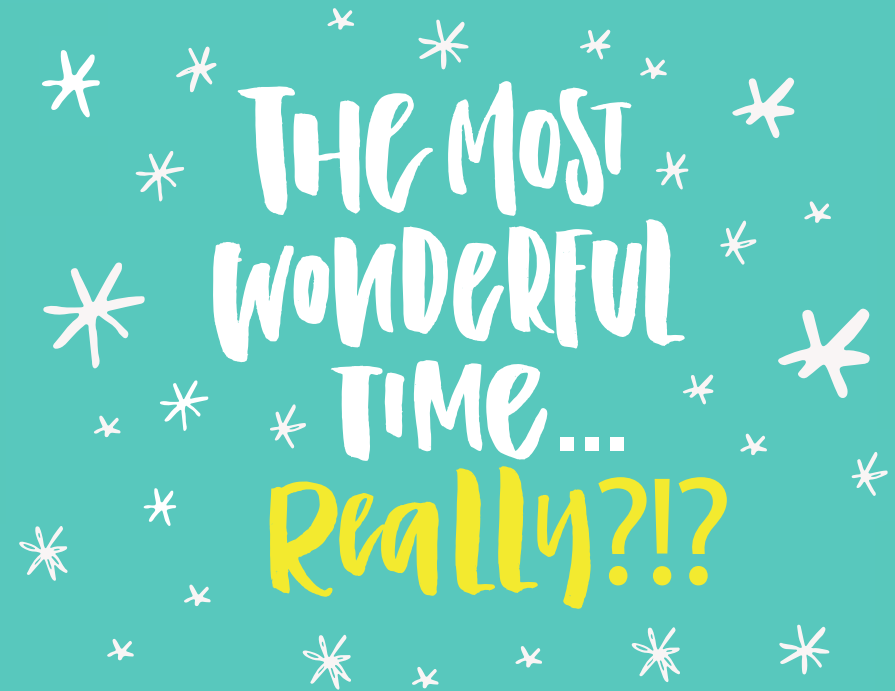
