## Further study for today's sermon / Mar. 15, 2020

The discussion questions below are a pathway for your Life Group to read and reflect together on a Bible passage relevant to today's sermon. It may or may not be tied directly to the sermon, but it will get your group discussing God's Word together. Let the message you hear this morning simply be the launching pad for seeking God throughout your upcoming week.

**IGNITE:** If you're honest, what are some people or things in your life that are currently (or are currently most dangerous of becoming) first place in your life over and above Jesus Christ? Practically speaking, most of us have more than one or two people or things—can you list a few?

**LAUNCH:** Take time to read Colossians 1:15-23 as a group. Then discuss the passage together. Use the following questions as a general guide.

- 1. What's something from this passage that stands out to you?
- 2. What questions does this passage raise for you?
- **3.** What can we learn about God from this passage? What can we learn about humanity?
- **4.** What can we learn about loving God from this passage? What can we learn about loving others?

**LAND:** What phrase or concept from the passage or discussion inspires you to action? How will you act on that this week? What takeaways from the passage or discussion inform our Life Group's core values of "Life Together"? How can we act on one of these as a Life Group moving forward?
