Reflection Questions

1 In what ways has society today made sexuality the defining characteristic of who we are as humans (consider the conversation both inside of the Church and outside of the Church)?

2 Read Genesis 1:25-27 and 9:6; Colossians 1:15 and 3:10; Romans 8:29; and 2 Corinthians 3:18. What do these passages tell us about our identity as humans at the most fundamental level? What does it mean that every human is made in the “image of God”?

3 Read 1 Corinthians 6:12-20. In what ways does the love of God in Jesus Christ define us as believers (beyond our sexuality)? How does the gospel inform our approach to sexuality?

4 How will the concepts from this conversation inform the way you relate to God moving forward? How will they inform the way you relate to others?
