## Discussion Questions

We are all prone to pursuing, valuing, and worshipping the gifts of God more than God, the giver of the gifts. When we do, we turn these gifts into idols. Idols are often as simple as a certain status, stuff, situation, or someone. What idols are most likely to dethrone God in your life?

Maybe the most overlooked form of idolatry is defining God according to our own preferences, positions, and purposes. What are some ways that you have potentially defined God on your own terms rather than on His own self-revelation?
