Passage Exploration Questions

The primary translation our pastors use on Sunday morning is the ESV. You may find it helpful to use the ESV along with corresponding notes in the ESV Study Bible when reflecting on the questions below.

Read I Cor. 11:2-16.

1 How does Paul move from congratulation to correction? What is commended and how does Paul shift the discussion in I Corinthians 11:3? What does Paul want the Corinthians to understand, and what is he saying about the relationships of men/Christ, wife/husband, Christ/God?

2 Related to the question above, what is the unique cultural issue that Paul is addressing in the church of Corinth and what does it have to do with head coverings? Note similarities and differences discussed throughout the passage.

3 Following the flow of Paul's argument, what is the main idea of this passage?

Application & Spiritual Formation Questions

1 In what ways does this passage speak (or not speak) to the body of Christ today? What do we learn about the ministry of both men and women in public worship and how does this passage help us as followers of Christ?

2 How does Danny's sermon affirm or potentially challenge how we read and understand this passage in light of redemption and the story of scripture?
