Just Be | Psalm 46 | Lucas Megrue

Passage Exploration Questions

The primary translation our pastors use on Sunday morning is the ESV. You may find it helpful to use the ESV along with corresponding notes in the ESV Study Bible when reflecting on the questions below.

Read Psalm 46.

1 Reflect on 46:1-7. How is God described throughout these verses?

2 What is the city of God and what is God's relationship to the city and its inhabitants? (See Psalm 48 and Revelation 22:1-4.)

3 Reflect on Psalm 46:8-11. What is God's work in the world and among the nations?

As we think about God being a fortress and refuge, dwelling from His holy habitation, being in control of what is happening in the world, and bringing forth global peace, what comfort and encouragement does “be still and know that I am God” offer us? Offer a summary statement that connects what you have learned about God’s character and His work in the world to being still and knowing God. Start with “I can be still knowing that God is/will...”
